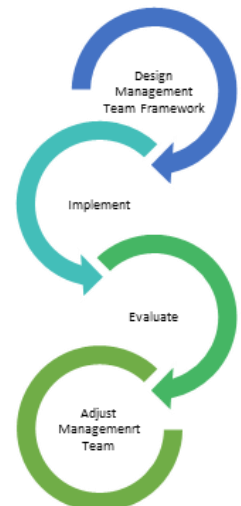


Volunteers in every capacity have a prescribed training in place.
