- Offers Unified Sports, where athletes with and without intellectual disabilities compete as a team.

- Partners with Wyoming High School Activities Association to host the Unified State Track & Field Championship.

-Goes beyond sports to offer Healthy Athletes, Young Athletes, and athlete leadership programs.

-Never asks athletes to pay to participate.

-Recruits more than 2,000 volunteers each year to assist with coaching, training, competition, and health services.

-Continues to grow and expand programming year after year to better serve our athletes.
